ReOpening Policies

Historic London Town & Gardens has re-opened in conjunction with county and state regulations as well as guidance from the Center for Disease Control. There are several new policies planned to keep you and all visitors healthy and safe.

Policies for the Entire Site

- Check in at the Visitor Center. For safety and per AACO law, masks are **required** at all times while inside for all persons aged 2 or over.
- No gatherings larger than 10 people will be allowed.
- The gardens, grounds, limited bathrooms, and reconstructed colonial buildings (Lord Mayor's Tenement and Carpenter Shop) are open.
- There will be outdoor only site tours at 11am and 2:30pm that start at the Visitor's Center. While on the tour, you must wear your mask at all times.
- The William Brown House is closed. Please check out our virtual tour of the building at <https://www.historiclondontown.org/wbhtour>.
- The Archaeology Lab is closed. You can contact them for an appointment at projects@losttownsproject.org.
- The *Discover London Town* exhibit is open from 10:00 am to 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm to 3:30 pm. The exhibit is closed from 12:30 pm to 1:00 pm for cleaning and sanitizing.
- Only 1 family unit per time in the historic area buildings.
- The site may close if we reach capacity.
- Anything brought onsite must be taken offsite.
- If you are sick, please stay home.
- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer before and after your visit.
- Consider wearing a face mask for the safety of you and others when outdoors.
- Practice social distancing. Leave 6 feet of space between you and others. If you wish to pass another person, please announce yourself and your intentions so that other person may move out of your way.

If you do not follow these policies, you will be asked to leave. Please note that these policies may be updated or change at any time. The health and safety of our members, visitors, volunteers, and staff is our first priority. Mandates and recommendations from government officials and the Center for Disease Control may change our ability to follow this new limited opening plan. If we find that guests are not following appropriate social distancing or other guidelines, we may be forced to completely close again.
